

# Wrapped Easter Egg Craft

Make sure to ask your mom or dad for help with this craft. Using a hot glue gun can burn you so **BE CAREFUL!** I omitted the beads, but if you have any go ahead and use them 😊

Here are the steps I took, if you can't access the website.

1. Cut egg template (next page)
2. Glue egg template onto cardboard/cardstock
3. Cut cardboard/cardstock
4. Cut a 1 cm slit down the top of your egg then
5. A. If you are using multi-colored yarn start wrapping  
B. If you are using solid ribbon/string cut pieces and tie ends together to make a long piece. About 2-3 feet, trim the knots (if needed)
6. Wrap Egg cut out as many times as your string/yarn will allow
7. Use hot glue gun to adhere string to egg with every wrap if needed
8. Finish off wrapping and glue the end piece of the string to back
9. Cut an extra piece of string to make a loop for your egg
10. Hang and enjoy your beautiful masterpiece!
