The Antichrist:

- Denies that Jesus is the <u>C</u>. (v22)
- Denies that the <u>S</u> of Jesus. (v23)
- Denies that Jesus came in the <u>F</u>. (1 John 4:1-3)

## The Doctrine of Assurance

- We are saved <u>i</u> <u>C</u> (1 John 2:24-25)
- We are saved by <u>G</u> through <u>F</u> (Romans 1:17)
- God then makes us His <u>C</u> (Romans 8:15)
- We gain a sense of <u>A</u> through the Holy Spirit (Romans 8:16)
- We <u>R</u> in Him (1 John 2:27)

- 1. Look up the verses on the back about Assurance and reread them together. Discuss. Do you have any questions for the group?
- 2. Hebrews 10:19–22 tells of another act that could help a believer gain assurance. What is it, and have you found it to be helpful?
- 1 John 5:13 tells about another aspect of assurance, that we can have assurance about one blessing of salvation. What is it? Do you find this hard to know in your heart?
- 4. How does a believer feel and act when she or he knows to be a child of God the Father? ...when she or he doesn't know?
- 5. Gnostics peddled their religion by saying they had secret knowledge. Is this what Jesus' disciples taught? How can we fight that instinct as well?
- 6. Is there someone the Spirit has pointed out whom you can encourage this week?
