## Sunday Seconds: "Seeing His Rule" (for small group discussion or personal reflection)

## Ephesians 1:15-23 - April 14, 2024

- 1. Pick one to answer: What does sunlight do for your eyes? ...your photos? ...your Saturdays?
- 2. 2 Corinthians 4:4 says a few helpful things about light. The "god of this age" has done what to unbelievers? In contrast, Christ is what to God? Describe what you think that means.
- 3. 2 Corinthians 4:5-6 says more. Paul and his fellow preachers display Jesus as one thing. Similarly, Jesus' face "shines" what?
- 4. In Jesus' own ministry, his face could have displayed God's glory to people how? And how does his resurrected body/face display God's glory now? Obviously, we are just conjecturing this, yet the scripture invites us to.
- 5. Paul tells the Ephesian churches that they can be enlightened (1:18) by the Spirit's wisdom. What was the immediate goal for this at the end of v17? How do you think that will help them with the other things in this passage?
- 6. 1 Peter 2:9 shares a high calling for God's people, all of them. How does this passage strike you?
- → This week, collectively pray for your Jesus' light to shine through you.
