Questions for reflection:

- What is unique about how God made you?
- How can you let God play His music through you?

Sunday Seconds: “Enlivened by Grace” (for small group discussion or personal reflection)

Ephesians 2:1-10 – April 21, 2024

1. Are you artistic? Is there anything you feel especially alive while doing?
 2. “Works righteousness” is the temptation to try to make ourselves good by imitating good things others do while ignoring the sin in our heart. What is the effect of this attempt?
 3. Adam Clarke said: “though we are not saved for our good works, yet we are saved that we may perform good works, to the glory of God and the benefit of man.” How do the good works God has given us to do glorify Him? When have you experienced this for yourself or through someone else?
 4. Read Galatians 5:6. Circumcision was the initiating act so that a Jew knew who he was. Paul is drawing a contrast. What is a way Christians know who we are?
 5. Sometimes we don’t feel like God can use us at all, but He desires to live through His people. How does 2 Corinthians 9:8 address this feeling?
